



- A Horizon 2020 project, under the heading « Supporting public authorities in the implementation of the Energy Union », from 1st June 2019 to 31st May 2021
- BPIE in partnership with the network of the **Green Building Councils** and **Climate Alliance** (+ 8 pilot cities)

SCOPE AND PROBLEM ADRESSED:

1. Support renovation of buildings and **avoid a piecemeal approach** between various levels of governments (EU, national and local).
2. Delivering the **EPBD** and ensure that local initiatives, particularly in **Covenant of Mayors'** cities, are aligned with national and European policies.
3. Establish a multi-level renovation framework that contains milestone measurable progress indicators and methods to measure impacts for building renovation strategies, **integrating data and insights from the local level.**



KEY SUCCESSES SO FAR

- Involving stakeholders across Europe, including by creating National Steering Committees in 8 countries, to provide input to the renovation framework.
- **20 followers cities** have already committed to apply the renovation framework (target for the all project duration was 10 cities).
