


- A Horizon 2020 project, under the heading « Supporting public authorities in the implementation of the Energy Union », from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2019 to 31<sup>st</sup> May 2021
- BPIE in partnership with the network of the Green Building Councils and Climate Alliance (+ 8 pilot cities)

## **SCOPE AND PROBLEM ADRESSED:**

- 1. Support renovation of buildings and avoid a piecemeal approach between various levels of governments (EU, national and local).
- 2. Delivering the EPBD and ensure that local initiatives, particularly in Covenant of Mayors' cities, are aligned with national and European policies.
- 3. Establish a multi-level renovation framework that contains milestone measurable progress indicators and methods to measure impacts for building renovation strategies, integrating data and insights from the local level.



## **KEY SUCCESSES SO FAR**

- Involving stakeholders across Europe, including by creating National Steering Committees in 8 countries, to provide input to the renovation framework.
- 20 followers cities have already committed to apply the renovation framework (target for the all project duration was 10 cities).
