
Putting Regions on Track for Carbon Neutrality by 2050

- C-Track 50 was initiated on March 1st 2018, and has a duration of three years.
- The ambitious long-term EU climate and energy targets, can not be solely achieved by the national governments. Local and regional authorities can play a decisive role.
- Key achievements include:
 - ✓ Ongoing work with 118 municipalities and 11 regions, covering approx. 5.56 million people.
 - ✓ Implementation of 50 roundtables with national, regional and local stakeholders.
 - ✓ Development of a set of policy recommendations on multi-level governance and national energy and climate planning.
- Next steps:
 - √ 116 energy and climate plans for carbon neutrality developed.
 - √ 105 projects identified and supported into financing proposals.
