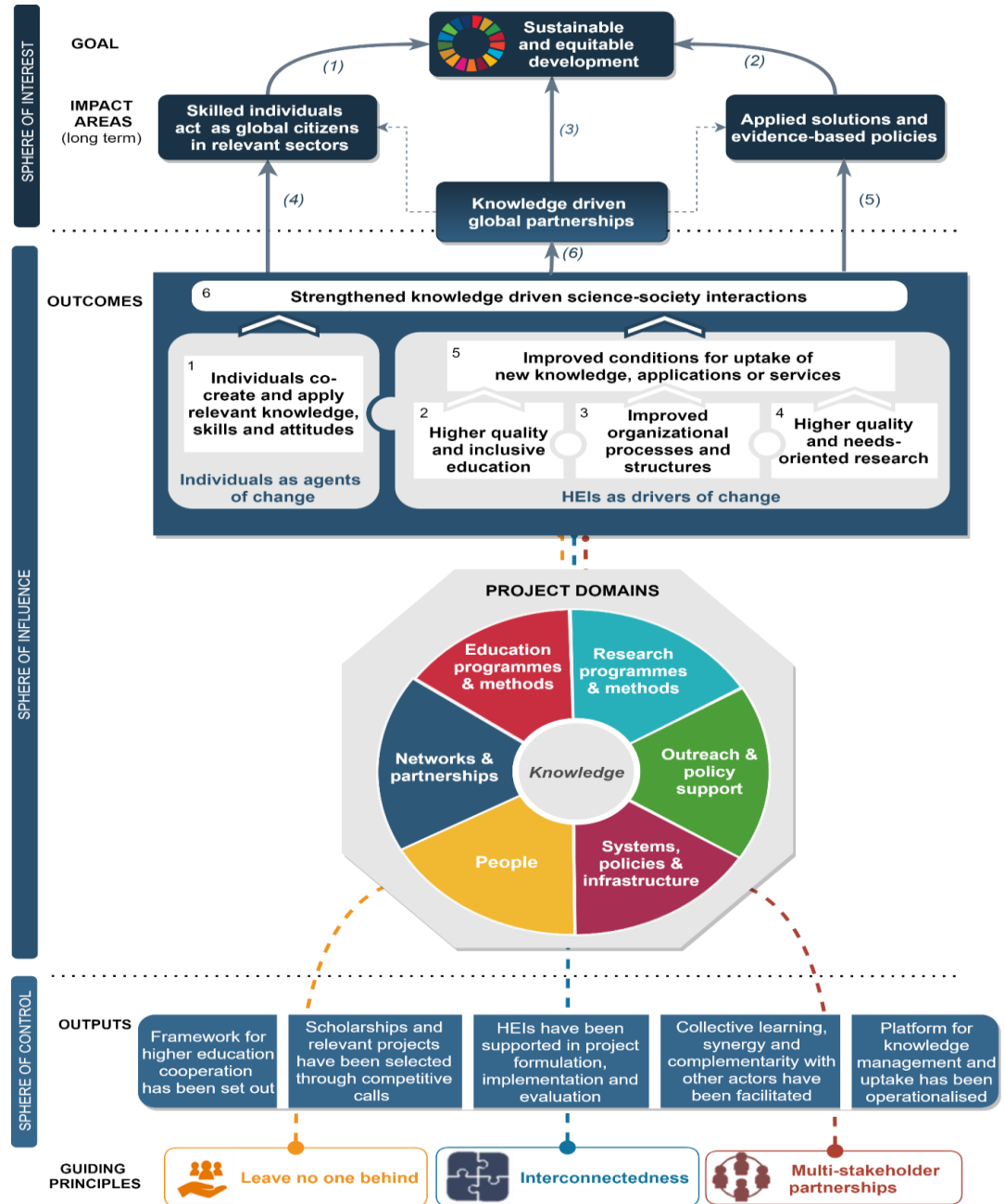
Revised Theory of change
